The historic Union Station Hotel is a stunningly adapted 100-year-old railway station that showcases the Romanesque architecture and design that first awed rail travelers in the early 1900s. Dramatic custom rugs and a marble floor with a multi-colored inlaid border reflect the motifs and colors of the lobby's original barrel-vaulted stained glass ceiling, and a bold polychrome paint scheme highlights iconic Richardsonian architectural details. Jewel-toned furniture lends a current look to the historic space, and light towers provide scale to a potentially overwhelming space. The lively lounge sports an absinthe, merlot and licorice color scheme, with a crystal-studded bar front and rich red Venetian glass chandeliers.
