The resort features a grand living room with expansive views of the property flanked by an intimate library and a cozy wine bar that features local wines from nearby vineyards as well as an extensive international wine list. The octagonal restaurant has generous seating and dramatic views, with a working wine cellar designed to accommodate private parties and special events. There is a billiard room as well as a cooking school, the meeting facilities are designed to host executive level retreats and luxurious social functions.
